Business on Note

1. Club Shirts, Judith and Christian modeled the new Canning River Canoe Club shirts. The shirts are red and black with a male and female cut and will cost \$20 for either type, Club has paid \$45 for the embroidered digitizing of the club logo, the disc is stored at the embroidery company: AB Embroidery 2/221 Scarborough Beach Rd WA 6016 Ph 94447335. This disc is CRCC property and can be transferred to any embroidery company should we wish – just need to contact the company. It was decided to buy a shirt for every existing member and to supply a shirt to all future members as part of joining the club, cost of the shirts to be paid for by fundraising. Additional shirts could be purchased from the club for \$20. Discussed the need to get a price for a paddling shirt made out of water proof "bike shirt" type material.

- Paddling Lessons, BO to offer paddling lessons, training by appointment
- **ACTION**: CT to advertise training by appointment on the CRCC website.
- Email from John.Mc, NO read email from John re' how we could raise funds for clubhouse. Bottom line is we have approved shire plans for building extension to Scout Hall. We need to raise \$30K to then get equivalent amounts from two other groups, totaling \$90K should be enough to establish a basic shed clubhouse.
